Our challenge for this project was "To put RED Lipstick on a Pig" This was truly a design build which required many hours of hands on . We were closing the existing Health Sciences library, so we were challenged to combine the 2 libraries. A primary goal was to give the existing and tired looking library a fresh and inviting new look. The existing library is one of the most heavily used facilities on our campus, therefore a tight time schedule was required. Way finding in the library was nonexistent and needed to be addressed. All interior finishes were in need of painting, as well as new lighting and carpet. We had an existing water feature that had been shutdown for several years and was an eye sore.

The entire project was actually enjoyable to be able to watch the transformation of an old space and bring it new life. Budget for this was \$1.2 M


ACCOMPLISHMENTS OR SPECIAL FEATURES:

The transformation was completed through several goals and accomplishments as follows:

- Created a visual "Street-Scape" as people enter the building from the primary pedestrian mall on our campus. Including, painting, lighting, plants, walk-off flooring, and many other features. The existing interior fountain area was transformed into a seating area with
- interior landscape and seating which adds to the "Street-Scape" appearance.

- Relocated 7 DIRTT rooms over from former Health Science Library. Repurposed, reupholstered, and moved all existing furniture. Installed new mobile shelving to create individual vignettes, store books and misc. items.
- Updated lighting to LED throughout including installation of new pendant LED lighting in the primary student seating areas.
- New carpet throughout the 1st and 2nd floor was installed as well as painting of walls
- Installed 4 ceiling "clouds" with new lighting to help breakup the large ceiling appearance.


The project was a huge success and provides our students and faculty a library that they are excited to see.
