## PROJECT STATEMENT:

This newly constructed 145,000-square-foot, five-story facility (which opened in August) this building will feature an interdisciplinary type instruction for future physicians, nurses, OTs, PTs, physician assistants and EMS technicians together to learn and work under one roof. An estimated 5,900 students, faculty, staff and visitors will use the building every year. The total project cost which included renovations to the Criss Complex — was \$90 million. The goal of the interior design was to offer a collaborative environment for all students and faculty.

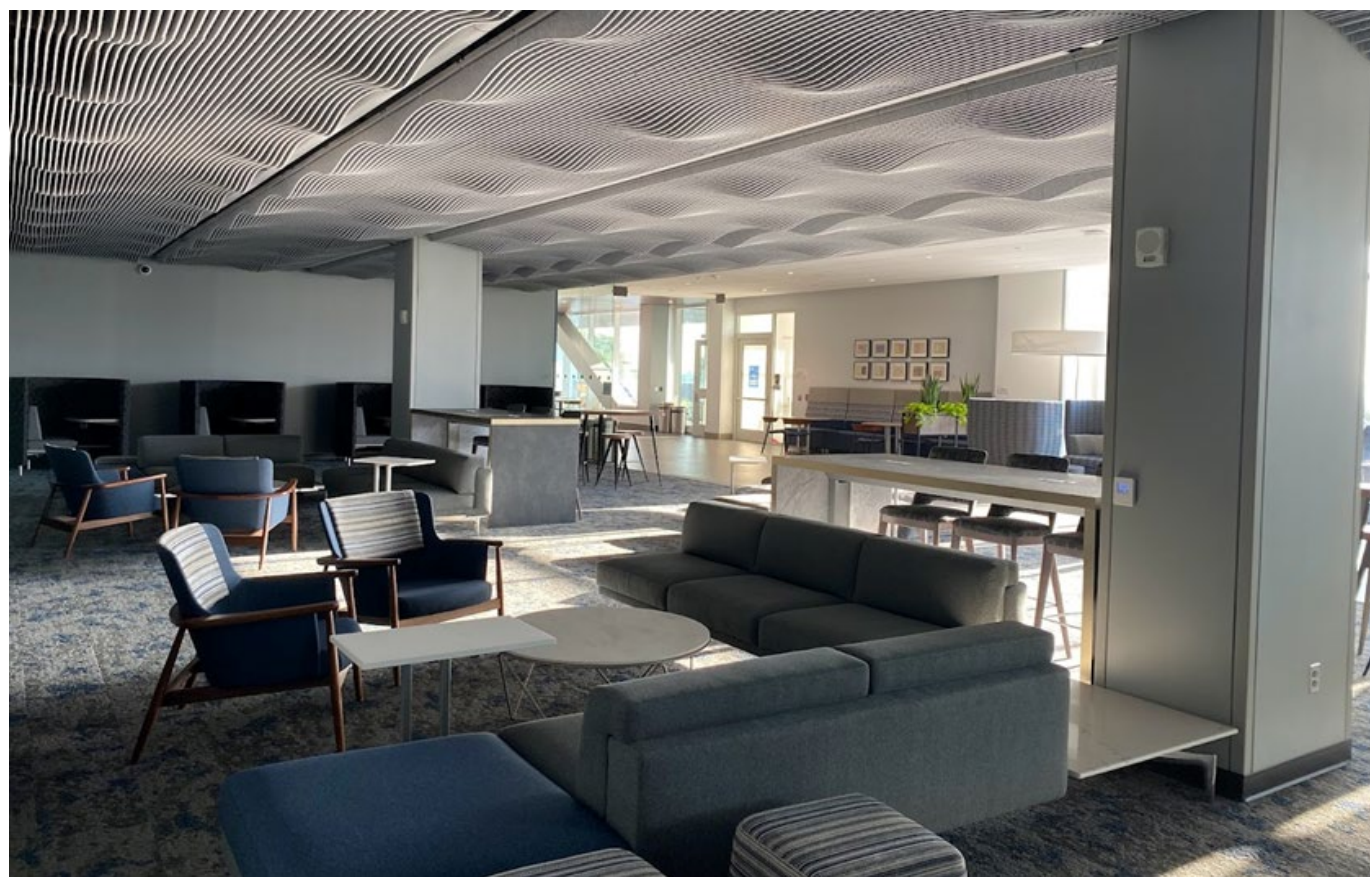
The Werner Center embraces Creighton's priority of sustainability in multiple ways. Also, decreasing Creighton's carbon footprint is the facility's design, with large, all-encompassing windows and open spaces inviting a significant amount of natural light into the building, leading to greater energy efficiency and, ultimately, lower operating costs per square foot.

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS OR SPECIAL FEATURES:

Several accomplishments were achieved by repurposing well over 500 pieces of furniture. Over 460 existing furniture pieces were reupholstered, including classroom and debrief room chairs, as well as the classroom and debrief room tables. Many Study pods, lounge furniture were re-purposed. Many additional items in the exam rooms and OT/PT labs, active learning classroom tables and chairs and Deans conference room table were repurposed and reupholstered. Refer to the highlighted floor plans, any items and areas highlighted in RED indicated where existing furniture was used. New furniture was also installed throughout the building that helps provide the collaborative and cohesive appearance that provides our students and faculty a well thought-out learning environment.



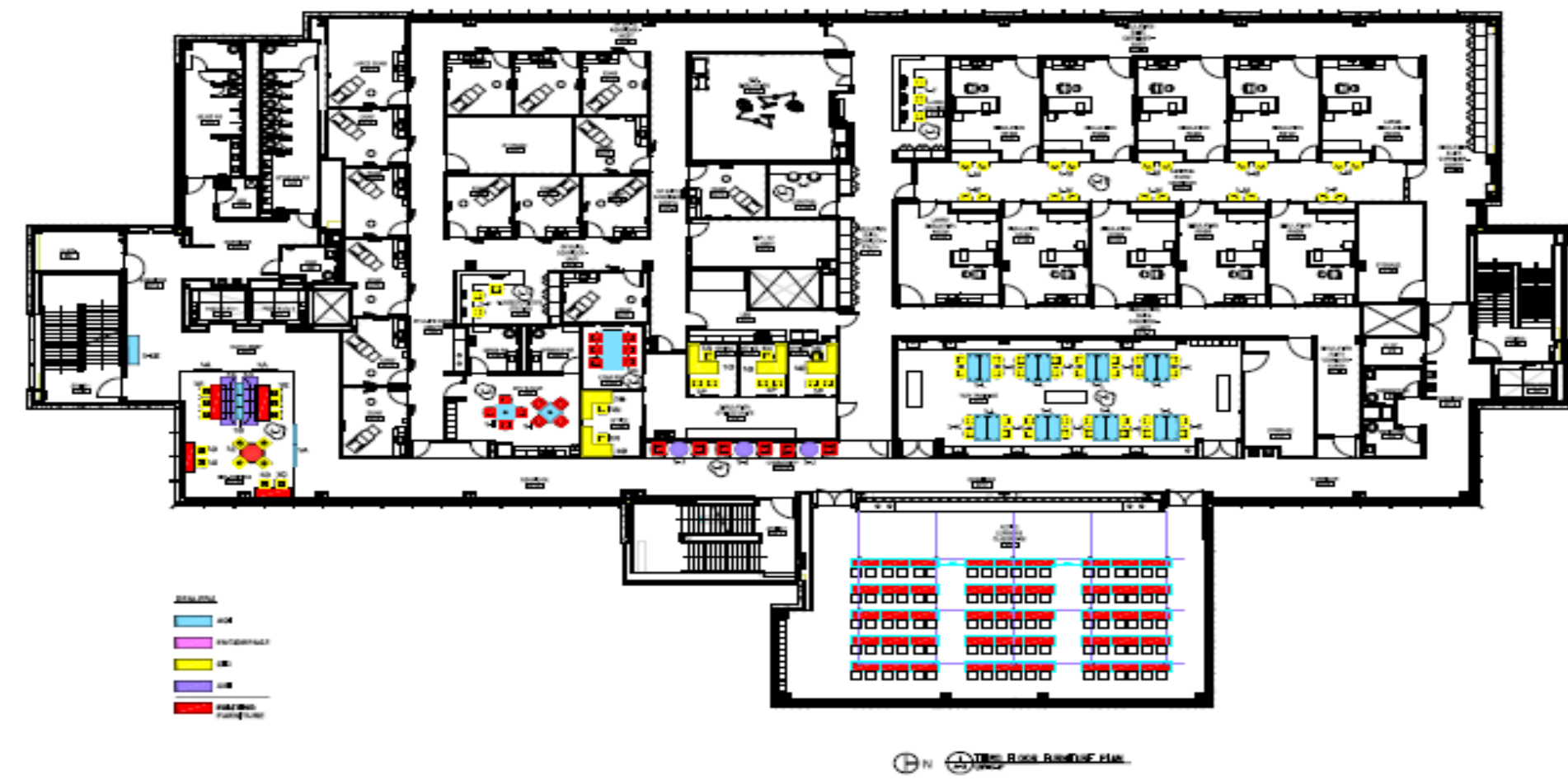
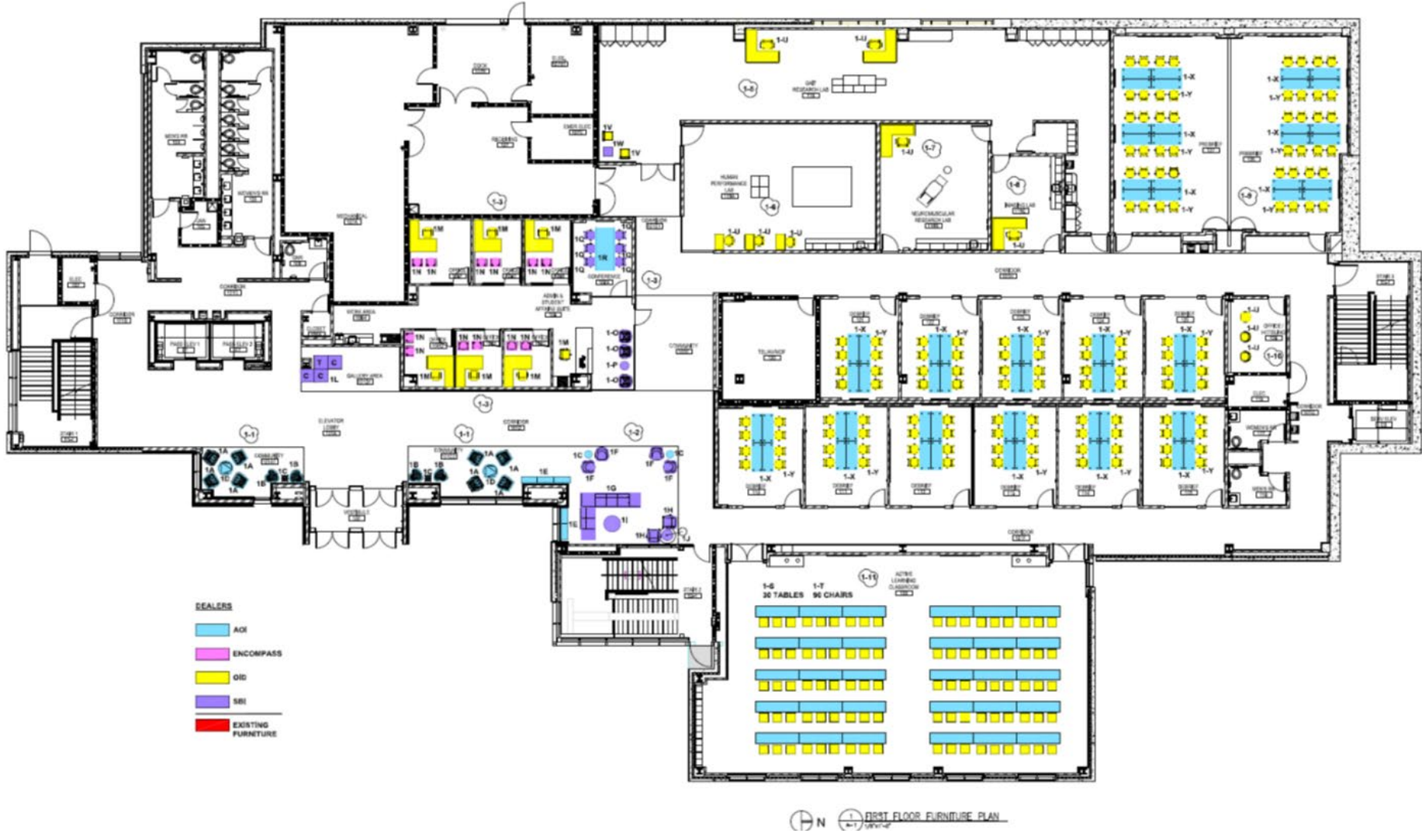
