# PROJECT TITLE: Eigenmann Library SQUARE FOOTAGE: 1244 sq.ft.

**PROJECT STATEMENT:** The library staff wanted to create a cozy environment for students to come check out books or movies, as well as to create a comfortable study place for students to come to within their residence hall. The staff were happy with the previous layout, but wanted to freshen things up and had a small budget to do so. It was important to them to try and attract students to make the library a more used space. The design accomplished their goals by incorporating comfortable and residential feeling materials, new furniture with integrated power, and multiple light sources. The overall budget was \$58,000. A mixture of existing and new furniture was used to stretch their budget. Several different zones were created to allow for different types of studying, reading, or playing games. Storage was moved out of the student space and a central reception area was added.

**ACCOMPLISHMENTS OR SPECIAL FEATURES:** Tables with integrated lamps and power were added to create a more intimate and functional study environment.


