PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Project scope was to update lobby finishes and remodel area office spaces to increase customer service and create a more functional package sorting station Before remodel, staff was seated at a desk configuration separate from the service openings, security gates had to be manually pulled down each night (usually by climbing on counter) and packages were sorted into boxes on the floor. There were two 30" door entries into the office and one of those entries would not not a lock the desk supervisor from getting into their office. potentially block the desk supervisor from getting into their office.


Flooring and wall finishes were bland and offered no school branding to the entry. Walnut plank walls were original to the building from 1965 and gave a very dated feel. Bench seating was worn down and uncomfortable.

Resident directors had very narrow offices that only allowed for them to meet with students while seated at their desks.


Designers created a single accessible entry door into area office directly across from the ramp into custom built package sorting island. Security gates at customer service windows were motorized and depth of service windows was extended to allow for staff of any ability to easily work at area office. Desk Supervisor office was relocated while still allowing sightlines

into the area office space.

Resident Director offices were expanded to allow for meeting table spaces along with the addition of desk space for office assistants. Flooring was updated to a large format rubber tile to cut down on the necessary maintenance time and brighten the space. Wall finishes and updated textiles at seating allowed for implementation of school brand colors within the space.




