The Torgersen Bridge is an iconic spot on our campus, spanning across Alumni Mall Road and connecting Newman Library to Torgersen Hall. It's a 24-hour quiet space where students study and becomes extra popular during exam time.

The two big reasons for updating this space were 1) the carpet was original to the building (20+ year old Powerbond product) and was showing some wear and 2) the University's logo had changed. As this is a prominent place on campus, University Branding wished to put the new logo into the new carpet.

I worked with Tarkett to create the logo in Powerbond using two solid colors that reflected our brand quite well, and used a different pattern of Powerbond to create the field of carpet with an accent in the main walking path. It took a lot of effort to get all the drawings and colors approved and sized, plus coordinating the furniture move and timing the project over an academic break, BUT the result was well worth it. Overall, the space seems warmer and refreshed. Everyone has been very pleased with the end product and we know the Powerbond can stand the test of time.


